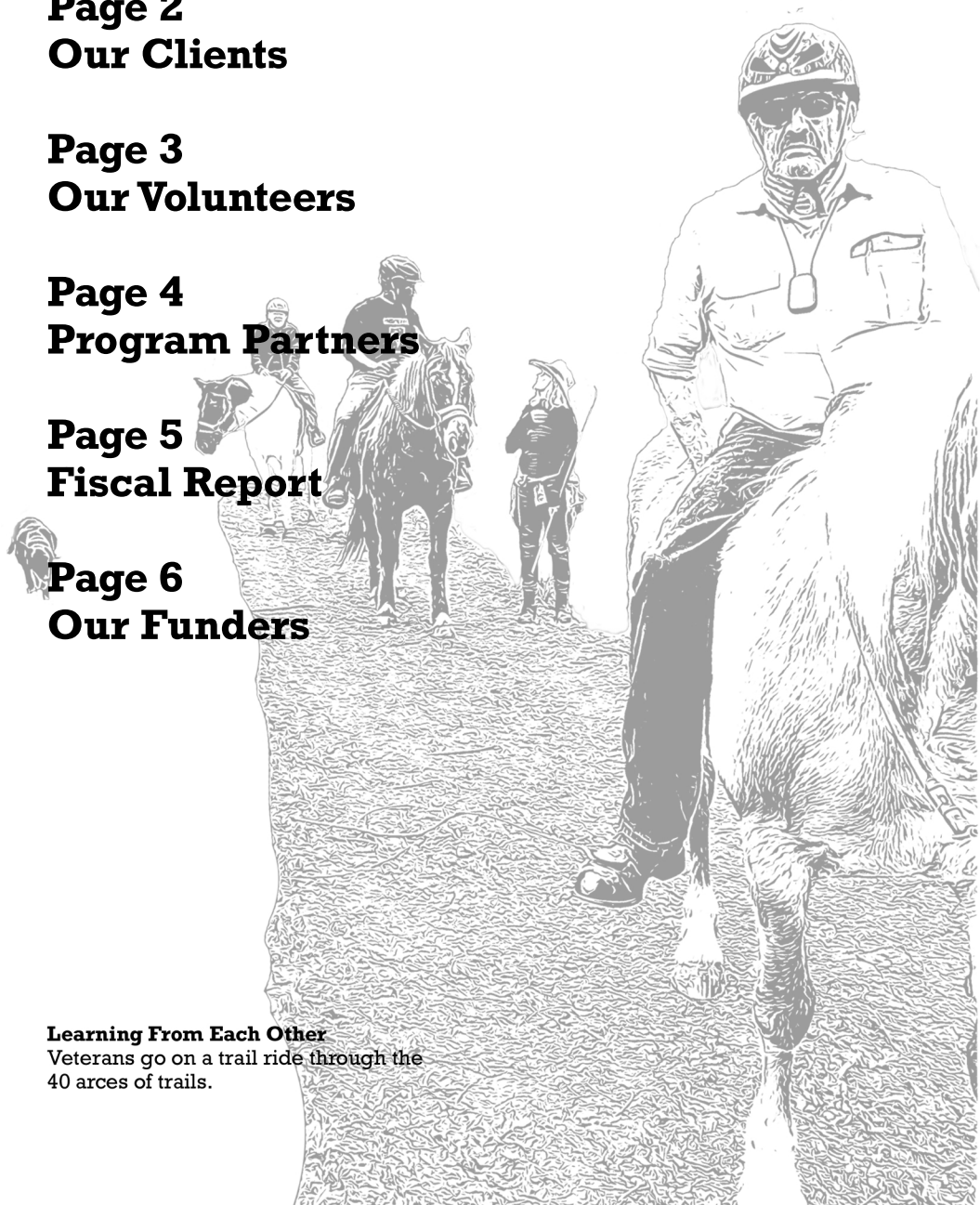

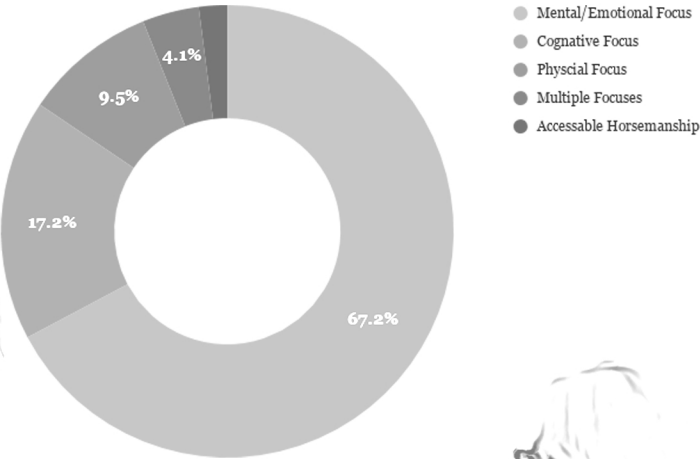

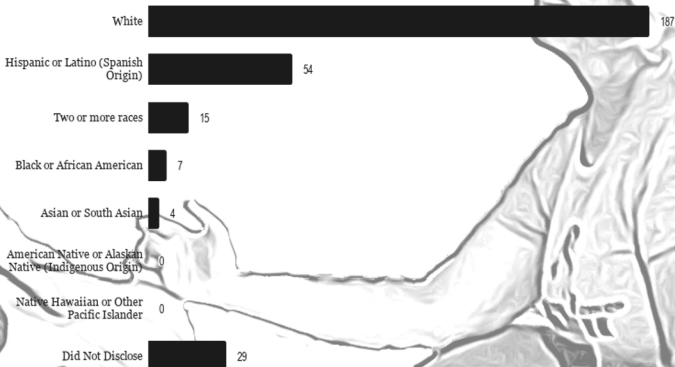
Our Clients

Healing with Horses Ranch works with a herd of great partners that help individuals access services.



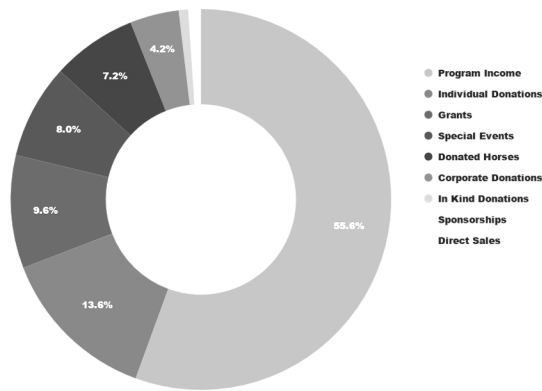

Fiscal Report

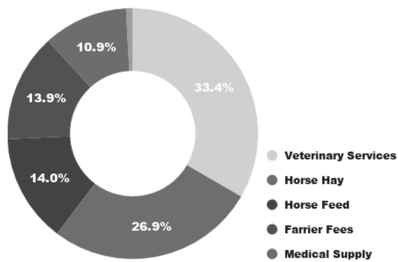
While Healing with Horses Ranch does charge a fee for service, these fees are charged on a sliding scale based on household income. Veteran services are always free to veterans.



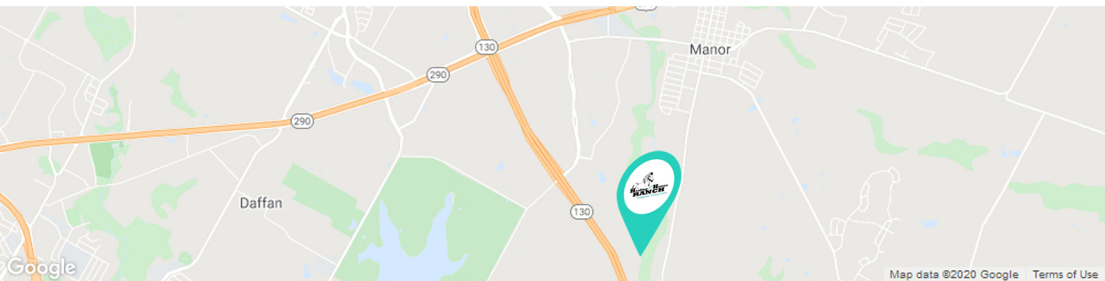

By creating space for healthy relationships between horses and humans, we help students learn life skills in a safe, inclusive environment. **We don't want to just touch lives, we want to change lives.**

Healing with Horses Ranch was founded in 2011 as a Professional Association for Therapeutic Horsemanship, International (PATH, Intl) member center by Patty D'Andrea, a PATH Intl Advanced Certified Therapeutic Riding Instructor and Certified Equine Specialist. In 2018, we became a PATH Intl Premier Accredited Center. We are based in Austin, TX, and serve South East Austin, Travis and Bastrop Counties, and surrounding areas.
